Report on Business

During the reporting month, the Issuer continued to explore new business opportunities with several prospects in its target market.

The Issuer announced that it has developed a cannabis beverage that mimics alcohol in that the uplifting and energizing effects of the cannabis is felt by the consumer in a short period of time. THC believes that this beverage is a solution to a major problem with cannabis beverages and edibles, as current products cause fatigue and drowsiness.

THC intends to patent this formula and is confident its beverage, to be named "THC KISS", when legally allowed, will bring a fresh experience to the adult use recreational cannabis market. Although production and sale of the beverage is not currently legal in Canada, it may become legal at a later date.

Due to the revolutionary process in formulating, and producing THC KISS, THC has petitioned Health Canada to consider releasing its product on grounds of *National Interest* as its properties are so unique it will change the way cannabis is currently consumed.

THC has received permission from Health Canada for the addition of six production areas and continues to expand its facility due to the high demand for its products. Further submissions have been made to Health Canada for additional grow areas to be approved. THC has also completed renovations of its head office in downtown Kelowna

THC is pleased to report it has been selected as a supplier by the Ontario Government and has begun the process of filling orders for provinces in anticipation of the October 17th launch. THC is continuing to work vigorously to secure supply agreements with various provincial governments.
