Advantagewon is focused on building consistent cash flow from low cost, low risk oil wells in Canada. AOC applies specialized expertise to increase oil recovery from 10-15% to up to 75% for each well. Once the enhanced recovery strategy is successfully applied, AOC will repeat the process

throughout the oil pool to maximize output and minimize cost and risk. For the month stated in this report, the Corporation continued its business development objectives of developing its current properties, seeking additional properties, increasing the Corporation's corporate brand awareness and corporate profile to the capital markets.

Management continued its corporate and business development endeavours as stated in point #1 of this form and it completed the following activities listed below:

March 30th, 2020 – Advantagewon announced that it had added additional production and production opportunities. The asset acquisition consists of multiple licensed well locations with current production and an inventory of reactivation candidates. The acquisition was from a private company.

March 12th, 2020 – Advantagewon announced that it had completed tying in the second Canadian well it acquired and which the acquisition was announced via press release on Feb 3, 2020. The second well is producing 40 Barrels of Oil Equivalent Per Day ("BOE/D"). The Corporation will receive 100% of the net revenue until it has recovered the cost of well currently estimated at \$60,000 CDN after which time it will become a 75% working interest owner.

March 3rd, 2020 – Advantagewon announced that it had entered into a debt for shares settlement with a Director of the Corporation. The Corporation issued 2,000,000 Common Shares at a price of \$0.01 CDN per Common Share to settle debts totaling \$20,000.00 CDN owed and due to the Director. The Corporation also announced that it has received notice of dispute with respect to its first Canadian well. The Corporation has engaged legal counsel and is reviewing various options. The Corporation believes that the dispute is without merit.
