**During August 2016, the Issuer completed a non-brokered private placement generating gross proceeds of \$585,402 through the issuance of 11,708,032 Units at \$0.05. Each Unit consists of one common share and one common share purchase warrant exercisable for one year from the date of issuance.**

**In connection with the private placement, \$27,950 finders' fees were paid in cash and 375,000 finders' warrants were issued at an exercise price of 10 cents for a period of one year from the date of issuance.**

**The proceeds of the private placement will be used to advance the company's feature film and virtual reality portfolio incubation, packaging, and development activities, including corporate development and general working capital purposes.**

**The Issuer issued an additional 665,000 common shares to extinguish debt in the amount of \$33,250.**
