PUDO is North America's first pick-up and drop-off service that is carrier agnostic. Its large network of convenient locations ensures reliable and secure delivery where you want it, when you want it.

Management of the Issuer is focused on pursuing new customers, strategic partners, and adding locations (referred to as "PUDOpoints").

In an arm's length transaction, PUDO retained the professional services of Adtron Inc. ("Stockpalooza") to assist in its marketing and outreach initiatives ("Agreement"). Stockpalooza has extensive experience working with companies that trade on the OTC markets having helped them increase their profile and generate interest in their story and progress. This Agreement is complementary to PUDO's plan to begin expansion in the US market and is an important step/phase on the path towards increasing PUDO's visibility in the market, at a time when the e-commerce marketplace is rapidly expanding and evolving. The Issuer is compensating Stockpalooza at \$15,000 USD per quarter, based on a one (1) year agreement that may be terminated by either party prior the commencement of any quarter.
