- The issuer worked on further developing its mobile App and also its VOIP whole business.

- on October 2, Upco announced, further to the recent agreement with Emoney plc, that it has commenced development of the interface between Emoney and the Upco application, regarding user authentication and transaction/account management. This is an important early step in the deployment of a full-featured mobile payment and transfer application, encompassing both Fiat and Cryptocurrencies, within our e-Wallet. Details regarding this innovative offering, which is in the advanced design stage, will be addressed in future news releases.

- on October 18, Upco announced it has closed the first tranche of the previously announced financing to raise up to \$1 million at \$0.22 per share and issue up to 4,550,000 shares of the Company. Pursuant to the first tranche, Upco has issued 1,967,998 shares at \$0.22 per share for gross proceeds of \$432,960. The Proceeds will be used for general working capital. All the shares issued will have a 4-month hold.

- on October 26, Upco announced it has closed the second tranche of the previously announced financing to raise up to \$1 million at \$0.22 per share and issue up to 4,550,000

shares of the Company. Pursuant to the second tranche, Upco has issued 1,363,636 shares at \$0.22 per share for gross proceeds of \$300,000. The Proceeds will be used for general working capital. All the shares issued will have a 4-month hold.

On October 29, Upco announced that it is actively seeking to leverage its blockchain and e-Wallet technology to support the emerging and rapidly growing Cannabis industry. According to CEO Andrea Pagani, "Our advanced blockchain e-Wallet will help to foster the security and legitimacy of this very significant sector, while also enhancing its supply chain efficiency. We are also exploring other potential synergies with the Cannabis industry, including reward programs."
