Along the right field homerun porch, there were AR markers where fans took pictures with their favorite All-Star players who were represented as AR Holograms.
- Imagination Park has moved its USA corporate headquarters from San Diego, California to Erie, Pennsylvania. Additional to a monthly cost savings, the company has close proximity to four local colleges as a large source of talent for internships and employment. Erie is also located close to the cities of Pittsburgh, Cleveland, Buffalo and Toronto. The company’s content concierge client team currently works in the Erie office and has created and managed recent campaigns for clients and events.
- ImagineAR™ Inc., the wholly-owned USA subsidiary of Imagination Park Technologies, is a sponsor for the Tall Ship Festival in Erie August 22-25, 2019.
