**The Issuer is a mineral exploration company primarily focused on the exploration and development of its Rogers Creek property ("Rogers Creek") and its Pilar Gold Project ("Pilar").**

**Rogers Creek is located in the Lower Lillooet River valley, approximately 90 km northeast of Vancouver, and 28 km south of Pemberton. It consists of 47 contiguous claims totalling 212 square kilometres. The Issuer is evaluating results of its initial exploration activities. Pilar is located near the town of Suaqui Grande in Sonora, Mexico. Pilar consists of two**

**concessions, the Guadalupeana concession and the La Sonora concession, totaling 105 hectares.**

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

**In April 2020 the Issuer's management assimilated and assessed data for the Pilar property, the first phase of the exploration program involving sampling soil material for assaying, and interpreting geophysical data surface mineralization and interpreting the geology was started.**

**In April the Issuer continued to analyze data from Rogers Creek including IP survey information obtained from summer exploration program.**

**In April the Issuer started an exploration program on the Pilar property that includes soil sampling and will proceed concurrently with a geophysical survey program carried over from March. Interpretation of geophysical data began in late April.**
