FinCanna Capital Corp. ("FinCanna" or the "Company") is a royalty investment company for the licensed cannabis industry. Over the past month, FinCanna has continued to work towards achieving its business objective of providing capital solutions to companies in the cannabis industry with large scale potential and a highly skilled and experienced operators,

which plan to produce high value, high demand licensed products or related products and services.

On June 6, 2021, the Company announced its wholly owned portfolio company that owns the proprietary ezGreen point-of-sale software has been approved by the City of Adelanto in California as the official point-of-sale vendor for city-sanctioned cannabis events.

The official approval by the City of Adelanto is an important endorsement for ezGreen, as it highlights the efficacy of its software with respect to real-time, compliant tax reporting by dispensaries, an important source of revenue for any legal cannabis jurisdiction nationally. Additionally, it positions ezGreen to showcase its POS solution, which includes fully customizable compliance reporting, workflow management and business analytics, to dispensaries participating in city-sanctioned cannabis events.

The City of Adelanto has approved ezGreen Compliance as the official point-of-sale vendor for licensed cannabis events held within its jurisdiction. The ezGreen POS was selected because it assists vendors in effectively tracking inventory and sales for efficient tax reporting and collection for the city, as well as the state of California, through the BCC and METRC track-and-trace program.

On June 23, 2021, the Company announce that four client brands of its investee company QVI, Inc. doing business as “The Galley”, a cannabis infused product manufacturer located in Sonoma County, California recently won “Best of” in four separate categories at leading industry event, WEEDCon 2021.

The WEEDCon awards were judged entirely by dispensary buyers with QVI manufacturing clients delivering an exceptionally strong showing claiming top honors in four separate categories; Best product F.A. Ninos, Smokin’ Green Pot Sauce, Best Ratio Tincture, Purablis, Best Beauty Product - Green Bee Botanicals, Best Confection Tossed, Sauced & Baked , caramel sauce. Winning top honors in several categories underscores the best in class, “one stop shop” value proposition of QVI’s versatile production capabilities at its 8,300 sq. ft. state of the art cannabis co-manufacturing facility, known as the “The Galley”, located in Santa Rosa, CA.

FinCanna's investee facilities and personnel make every effort to comply with all governmental directives and guidelines relating to COVID-19.
