**On August 4, the Issuer announced it had engaged JWC Market Awareness Group Inc. (“JWC”) to provide the Issuer with marketing services for an aggregate amount of USD \$1,500,000.**

**On August 5, the Issuer announced it had commenced a ground geophysical survey program at the Issuer’s wholly-owned Freeman Creek Gold Property (the “Freeman Creek Property”).**

**On August 13, the Issuer announced it had engaged Flathead Marketing Group (“Flathead”) to provide the Issuer with social media management services over a 6 month contract for a total cost of USD\$50,000.**

**On August 17, the Issuer announced it had fulfilled all its obligations pursuant to the acquisition agreement on the Freeman Creek Property, exercising its option in full, and is now the 100% owner of the Freeman Creek Property.**

**On August 19, the Issuer announced it had commenced an expansive exploration campaign at its flagship Corvette-FCI Property, Quebec (the “Corvette Property”), which includes remote sensing, ground and airborne geophysical surveys, as well as prospecting and rock sampling.**

**On August 24, the Issuer announced its plans for an inaugural drill program at the Corvette Property.**
