The Company recently signed an LOI with JMX for a Nevada Gold and Silver Project called Jessup. The Property is 63 miles northeast of Reno, Nevada in Churchill County. A 2018 Resource Development Associates technical report, authored by Scott Wilson, SME-RM, CPG, includes a historic measured and indicated resource containing 331,800 ounces gold equivalent 0.606 grams per

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tonne at a 69:1 silver-gold ratio. The Company is not treating the Project resource estimates as current and has to complete sufficient work to classify these historical estimates as current mineral resources. The Company does believe that this historical estimate is indicative and the information may be of assistance to readers.

**On September 8th, 2021** the Company announced the Extension of Due Diligence Period on Gold-Silver Project in Nevada and Continued Exploration at Clover Mountain in Idaho
