**The Issuer is engaged in the business of mineral exploration and the acquisition of mineral property assets in Canada. Its objective is to locate and develop economic precious and base metal properties of merit and to conduct its exploration program on the Lemon Lake property, which is comprised of seven contiguous mineral claims that cover 2,646 ha in the Cariboo Mining Division in central British Columbia, approximately 8 km east of the hamlet of Horsefly and 65 km east of Williams Lake.**

**During the month of June 2022, the Issuer completed 501 metres of diamond drilling of two holes on the Lemon Lake property.**

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

**During the Month, management's principal activities consisted of activities which included, but were not limited to, discussion on and the preparation of necessary documentation in respect of:**

- (i) overseeing the administration of the drilling program on the Lemon Lake property;**
- (ii) payments to vendors and suppliers of services relating to the business of the Issuer; and**
- (iii) general management and administrative matters.**

3. Describe and provide details of any new products or services developed or offered. For resource companies, provide details of new drilling, exploration or production programs and acquisitions of any new properties and attach any mineral or oil and gas or other reports required under Ontario securities law.

**During the month of June 2022 the Issuer initiated and completed 501 metres of diamond drilling of two holes on the Lemon Lake property. Drilling core samples were sent for assay and laboratory analysis, and the resulting assay reports were received by the Issuer on August 31, 2022. The Issuer's consulting geologist reviewed the assay results and prepared a Exploration Report dated September 30, 2022 summarizing the 2022 drilling program. In the Exploration Report the geologist recommended further analysis of the data. The Issuer has only had the Exploration Report for a few days and plans to review it in greater detail over the next several weeks but has not yet concluded if any further exploration work on the Lemon Lake property is warranted. The decision to perform any additional exploration work is affected not only by the 2022 drilling program results, but also the commodities market with respect to the price of gold and copper, as well as the capital markets and the Issuer's ability to raise funds to perform further exploration of the Lemon Lake property.**

**The Issuer has no history of earnings and to date has not defined any commercial quantities of mineral reserves. The Issuer and its assets may become subject to uninsurable risks. The Issuer's activities may require permits or licenses which may not be granted to the Issuer. The Issuer competes with other companies with greater financial resources and technical facilities. The Issuer may be affected by political, economic, environmental and regulatory risks beyond its control. The Issuer is currently largely dependent on the performance of its directors and officers and there is no assurance the Issuer can retain their services. In recent years both metal prices and publicly traded securities prices have fluctuated widely.**

**The outbreak of the coronavirus ("COVID-19") pandemic is likely to impact the Issuer's plans and activities. The Issuer may face disruption to operations, supply chain delays, travel and trade restrictions and impact on economic activity in affected countries or regions can be expected and can be difficult to quantify. Such pandemics or diseases represent a serious threat to maintaining a skilled workforce industry and could be a major health-care challenge for the Issuer. There can be no assurance that the Issuer's personnel will not be impacted by these pandemic diseases and ultimately that the Issuer would see its workforce productivity reduced or incur increased medical costs/insurance premiums as a result of these health risks. In addition, the COVID-19 pandemic has created a dramatic slowdown in the global economy. The duration of the COVID-19 outbreak and the resultant travel restrictions, social distancing, government response actions, business closures and business disruptions, can all have an impact on the Issuer's operations and access to capital. There can be no assurance that the Issuer will not be impacted by adverse consequences that may be brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic on global financial markets which may result in reduced resource prices, share prices and financial liquidity and thereby may severely limit the financing capital available.**
