Recent developments regarding the Issuer's business and operations

On March 6, 2019, the Issuer announced that it had been selected to provide security guarding services to the Liquor Control Board of Ontario ("LCBO") for stores located in the Northern, Eastern and Western Regions. The initial term of the contract is two years with the option to renew annually for up to five years.

On March 12, 2019, the Issuer announced that it is providing secure transport and guarding services to Up Cannabis Inc. ("Up Cannabis"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Newstrike Brands Ltd. The significant growth potential of Up Cannabis, with provincial distribution agreements in seven provinces and expansion underway to increase annual production capacity to over 40,000 kilograms, is well aligned with 3 Sixty's strategic priorities which include significant organic growth by adding new customers and the expansion of security services offered to existing customers within the recently legalized cannabis industry.

On March 19, 2019, the Issuer announced that it had been selected by Harvest One Cannabis Inc. ("Harvest One") to provide a portfolio of security services which include secure transport, secure cannabis storage and retail deliveries. Harvest One has a global portfolio of brands including United Greeneries, Satipharm, Dream Water, and Burb that serves the adult recreational and medical cannabis markets from cultivation to retail distribution. The global footprint of Harvest One, with a presence in five countries, aligns with 3 Sixty's strategic goals of realizing significant organic growth and accelerating growth using M&A to expand operations within Canada, the United States of America and internationally.
