Sitka Gold Corp. is a mineral exploration company headquartered in Canada and managed by a team of experienced mining industry professionals. The Company is focused on exploring for economically viable mineral deposits with its primary emphasis on gold and copper mineral properties of merit. Sitka currently has an option to acquire a 100% interest in the RC, Barney Ridge, Clear Creek and OGI properties in Yukon and the Burro Creek Gold property in Arizona. Sitka owns a 100% interest in its Alpha Gold property in Nevada, it’s Mahtin Gold property in the Yukon and it’s Coppermine River project in Nunavut.

- **On June 8, the Issuer announced that it has commenced drilling at its RC Gold Project (“RC Gold” or “the Project”), located approximately 110 kilometres east of Dawson City, Yukon (Figure 1). The Company plans to drill 10,000 metres with drilling focused on expanding the extent of gold mineralization discovered at the Saddle-Eiger Zone where significant widths of gold mineralization were intersected during Sitka’s inaugural drilling program conducted in 2020 (Figures 2 and 3).**

- On June 22, the Issuer announced that it has begun mobilizing crew and equipment in preparation for the upcoming drilling program at the Company's Alpha Gold Project, located at the southeast end of the Cortez Trend approximately 40km southeast of the Barrick/Newmont Cortez gold mine complex. O'Keefe Drilling, an experienced and highly regarded drill contractor, has been secured to conduct this next phase of drilling. The Company amended its drill permit to allow for drilling an additional six sites to follow up on newly discovered strong Carlin-Type alteration southeast of drill holes AG21-02 & 03. These two discovery holes intersected long intervals of anomalous gold and very strong pathfinder elements known to be associated with Carlin-type gold deposits (see Sitka news releases dated May 6th & 21st, 2021). Sitka intends to drill a minimum of 1,500 metres in this initial follow up phase.
