The Issuer is engaged in the business of managing and exploring its existing mineral projects and, if deemed appropriate, acquiring other mineral projects focused on prioritized commodity exploration around critical minerals and precious metals. The Issuer is currently focused on its Five Point Copper-Gold Project near Houston, British Columbia and its North Preston Uranium Project in Saskatchewan's Athabasca Basin.

Recent exploration results by American Eagle Gold Corp. at their NAK Project located to the northeast of the Smithers-Houston area, approximately 100km from the northern mining claim of the Five Point Copper-Gold Project highlights the potential for increased exploration interest during 2024 in the area pertaining to its prospective endowment of critical minerals (e.g. copper) and precious metals (e.g. gold).
