On January 11, 2023 the issuer announced that it has commenced drilling at its Shatford Lake project in the Winnipeg River pegmatite region in southeastern Manitoba, Canada.

On January 19, 2023 the issuer reported that its recent geological field review and sampling program at Fish Lake Valley, Nevada has resulted in the highest surface lithium values to date with up to 1325 ppm lithium.

Further to the announcement on January 19, 2023, on January 26, 2023 the issuer announced a teaming agreement with ASTERRA, an Israel-based satellite technology company to utilize ASTERRA's Synthetic Aperture Radar (SAR) data analytics, patented algorithms and artificial intelligence, ("ASTERRA Technology") to identify lithium specific targets. ACME Lithium is the first in the United States to use ASTERRA's technology.

On January 31, 2023 the issuer announced that Phase 2 drilling has commenced at ACME's Clayton Valley Nevada lithium brine project.
