Peekaboo Beans is a children's apparel brand with a focus on environmentally responsible clothes that are intentionally designed to inspire play. Through an omni-channel approach, Peekaboo Beans engages sellers through social platforms, including Instagram and Facebook, as well as online retailers, to maximize revenue and build brand loyalty. The Issuer

works to promote a playful lifestyle for children by designing comfortable clothes that are built to last.

The Issuer announced a significant decrease in spend as a result of the Issuer's new omni-channel business model. Retail trends have pushed businesses to appeal to the millennial shopper through an online presence, which powered the Issuer's shift from direct sales to omni-channel model. The shift in the business model has significantly reduced operational costs through decreasing payroll including organization changes, and lower software expenses among other initiatives to reduce annual costs and generate higher revenue margins for the Issuer.
