From June 3, 2016 to March 24, 2019 the Company converted 13,816,806 debentures along with the accrued interest to common shares. On March 25, 2019, another portion of common shares (1,500,000) was issued to the debenture holders. As a result, the Company has 130,000 outstanding debentures as of today.


