During the month of November 2016, the Company continued to develop the drone service business and its benefits for growers as it applies to agriculture in southwestern Ontario. During the month, the Company announced the completion of a commercial contract with Bonduelle North America. Bonduelle

North America is part of the Bonduelle Group, the largest producer of ready-to-use vegetables in the world.

The contract continues to highlight the company's progress in signing up enterprise level customers to its drone data solution.

During the month of November 2016, management focused on developing the drone service business through reaching out to current and future channel partners for future drone data sales.

Bonduelle North America is a well-established vegetable processing business in the Americas with over 2,000 employees and 800 growers who grow over 100,000 acres across 17 different vegetable crops and operates several production sites: 8 in Canada, 4 in the United States. These sites are used to transform frozen and canned vegetables and a variety of canned sauces, baked beans, legumes and soups. As well as producing for major retail brands, the American subsidiary also markets vegetables under its own brands, including Arctic Gardens and Graves in Canada, and Bonduelle in Canada and the United States.
