The Company's business is comprised of two divisions – the STAR-A.D.S. ® Division and the STAR-M.M.I. ™ Division, and one subsidiary, Star- Isonoe Inc.

The STAR-A.D.S.® Division continues to pursue sales opportunities both locally and abroad for the STAR-A.D.S.® System, as well as for its variants, the Land System Aided Medical Monitoring system ("STAR-LSAMM™) solution for land ambulance patient data transfer, and the In-Flight System Aided Medical Monitoring ("STAR-ISAMM™) MEDEVAC helicopter product. The STAR-M.M.I.™ Division continues to fulfil existing contracts and to develop new business opportunities.

An RFP was received from an existing STAR-A.D.S.® System customer respecting two additional Systems for fleet installation.

Discussions have reached the final documentation stage with respect to two helicopter-based air ambulance companies. The Company expects the agreements to be finalized next month for the commercial launch of the STAR-ISAMM™ (MEDEVAC) system.

Star- Isonoe Inc. continues to support the efforts of the Company, and is actively engaging in R&D and sales development activities.

The efforts of management during the month continued to be focused on the MEDEVAC applications of its patented technology and on potential sales opportunities in the airborne emergency medical transfer sector, mainly helicopters and ground ambulances.

In addition, a complete review of staffing and resource allocation is now complete.

Management has also been significantly engaged in dealing with management succession discussions during the month.
