The Issuer is an agricultural biotech company focused on developing and commercializing a portfolio of patented natural bio-pesticides and bio-fertilizers, including its patented signature mustard-derived biologic, targeting the fruit, vegetable and cannabis industries.

During the period the Issuer focused on the following:

- **Continuing research and development studies with the National Research Council Canada assessing the Issuer's patented natural biopesticide as a pre-plant, pre-pot soil treatment for soil-borne pests and diseases that affect cannabis production, including but not limited to:**
 - o **Botrytis (grey mold, bud rot), a serious and common disease often brought into facilities via contaminated soil; and**
 - o **Fusarium and Rhizoctonia (root rot), known to destroy entire cannabis production rooms which can lay dormant in both soil and waterlines for years before becoming active and detrimental.**
- **Evaluating third party bio-pesticide and bio-fertilizer products and technologies for potential collaboration and distribution to the cannabis industry.**

During the period, management was primarily focused on the activities detailed in section 1 as well as exploring other strategic initiatives in the cannabis, fruit and vegetable production industries.


