#### **Report on Business**

During the month of April 2019, the Issuer completed the following milestones, through Opco (defined below):

Opco continued to work on necessary site adjustments, site planning, site infrastructure adaptation and preparation for storage capacity upgrade, as well as undergoing HACCP & GMP certification in its production facility in the village of Mladenovo, a centre for Industrial Hemp growing. During the former month period, Opco continued the adaptation of this facility in order to address technical matters related to the production optimization and storage capacity along with storage viability, and environmental and humidity control system.

Furthermore, Opco finished planning and started installation of proper ventilation system in Makish extraction facility. Extraction facility team lead by Prof. Dr. Bojan Mitic, optimized extraction process for increased quality and consistency of final product. The facility and the team are ready for production. Opco is undergoing process to obtain a full extraction license. Extraction facility has started with employee work schedule adjustments, due to satisfactory test production output. Opco is preparing to start 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> shift.

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

In April 2019, the Company explored potential partnerships for extraction processing of the current hemp in inventory. Management went to visit facilities in Romania and Macedonia in search of a partner with available capacity to extract and produce CBD in the near term.

Keeping with the focus on securing an extraction license in Serbia, the ventilation at the Makish facility is in process of being revamped as a final checklist item for securing the extraction license, pending final inspection. Expected completion date: end of May 2019.

The Company filed its Q2 unaudited interim financial statements.

The Company's Controller visited the Serbian operations, met the team, visited the facilities and visited Romania to evaluate the potential partnership opportunity.
