The Issuer is one of three defendants named in an action commenced by Rees Baron, as plaintiff, on November 29, 2018 in the Supreme Court of British Columbia under Vancouver Registry No. S-1812770. The plaintiff has claimed CDN \$120,000 from the Issuer, Vapergy International, LLC and Brent Skoda pursuant to an alleged finder's fee agreement among the parties. The Issuer is contesting the claim and filed its Response to Civil Claim on December 21, 2018. Vapergy International, LLC and Brent Skoda filed their Response to Civil Claim on July 5, 2019.

The Issuer is also one of a number of defendants in an action commenced on July 13, 2020 by Curtis Heffernan, a former officer of the Issuer, in the Superior Court for the State of California (County of Los Angeles) under case number 20STCV25549. The plaintiff has made certain claims against the Issuer with respect to matters concerning his departure and the Issuer is planning on defending the action.

On February 26, 2021, a complaint was filed in the Southern District Court of Florida - JHO INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY HOLDINGS, LLC et al v. Ignite International, Ltd. et al. The plaintiff alleges trademark infringement of its mark SRO by the Issuers energy drink Z-RO. The complaint also alleges the Issuer induced a former employee of the plaintiff to breach the non-compete agreement provisions of their contract while working for the Issuer.
