The previous month saw a reversal to the benefits that the COVID-19 pandemic provided to our online activity and key site metrics. June's organic user sessions ('traffic') declined to pre-lockdown levels, down 17% from May. During the previous three months, online site activity had increased dramatically in large part due to a general increase in Internet traffic globally, with many people under strict lockdowns and spending an inordinate amount of time surfing for information online.

The opening up of various U.S. states over the past several weeks appears to have reversed that trend and has had an adverse impact to the search volume within the cannabis online niche as evidenced by our decline in direct traffic and SEO community chatter.

We anticipate our monthly traffic and other site metrics will continue to gradually increase over the coming quarter as we introduce various traffic acquisition and site optimization strategies.

- Dispensaries on Site: 6,602 +4.0% m/m
- Brands on Site: 2,708 +0% m/m

Following the change, management began to finalize the revenue targets to be pursued by the sales team based on the previous months' of internal testing of various online advertising opportunities. It is anticipated that these initiatives will commence within the next month.
