The Issuer continues to take steps to execute on its phase 1 work program on the Alexo-Dundonald Project, as recommended in the 43-101 technical report prepared for the property.

On October 22, 2020, the Issuer also announced a non-brokered equity financing consisting of an offering of flow-through units ("FT Units") at \$0.80 per FT Unit

and hard dollar units (“HD Units”) at \$0.70 per HD Units for gross proceeds of up to \$3,000,000, subject to the Issuer’s overallotment option at its discretion (the “Offering”). Each FT Unit will consist of one flow-through common share and one-half of one common share purchase warrant exercisable for 36 months from the date of issuance at an exercise price of \$1.05 per whole warrant. Each HD Unit will consist of one common share and one common share purchase warrant exercisable for 36 months from the date of issuance at an exercise price of \$1.00 per whole warrant. The Issuer intends to close the financing in tranches.

The net proceeds from the Offering shall be primarily for completing the phase 1 recommended drill program on the Alexo-Dundonald Project and satisfying the drill requirements to exercise the option on the Somanike Project. Funds in excess of the above requirements will be used for general corporate and working capital purposes.

Management was focused on raising capital needed for working capital and to satisfy expenditure commitments for the Alexo-Dundonald Project.

The Issuer has contracted with Geotech Ltd. to fly an extensive VTEM plus time-domain electromagnetic survey with additional horizontal magnetic gradiometry over its entire Alexo-Dundonald Nickel-Copper-PGE property to identify new nickel targets.


