The Issuer announced on December 13, 2019 that it has entered into an Agreement and Plan of Merger dated December 9, 2019 with its 46% controlling shareholder BioHarvest Ltd. who owns the Biofarming technology. In addition to increase value to CNVC, the merger brings a number of advantages including:

1. No royalty payments;
2. Ownership of the bio reactor technology platform; and
3. Qualified and experienced staff.

This transaction constitutes a fundamental change under the rules of the Canadian Security Exchange. Consequently, trading of the Company's securities has been halted until completion and final approval of the transaction.

The Issuer also announced that it will issue up to 35,200,000 common shares at \$0.15 per share in a concurrent Private Placement.

The terms of the Agreement and Plan of Merger as well as the terms of the concurrent private placement have been disclosed in the Company's News Release dated December 13, 2019.

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

Following the completion of the feasibility program in September 2019 by producing Cannabis cells in suspension, with a cannabinoid profile identical to that of the Cannabis Plan; the management has been focusing on finding an opportunity to support the Company's next stage, which includes the development of a facility with a production capacity of 2Tons/Y. After 3 months of due diligence, management was pleased to announce on December 13, 2019 that it had entered into an Agreement and Plan of Merger for CannaVcell to acquire 100% of BioHarvest which will bring significant advantages. Management continues to engage with strategic parties and potential partners to leverage the Biofarming technology.
