Canadian Palladium Resources Inc. (the "Issuer") (CSE: BULL) is an independent mineral exploration company based in Vancouver, B.C. During March 2020, the Issuer released rush sample results from the first diamond drill hole on its East Bull palladium property in Ontario, Canada. Subsequently, the Issuer suspended drilling due to COVID-19 and the Ontario government's declaration of a state of emergency and the federal directive to socially isolate.

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

Management focused on its East Bull exploration program, achieving the required minimum work commitments on the East Bull property, and issuing the cash and share payments pursuant to the Option Agreement.

The Issuer released rush sample results from the first diamond drill hole on its East Bull palladium property, 90 kms west of Sudbury, ON. Hole EB-20-01 was designed to assess the areas of higher-grade palladium. These higher-grade palladium zones will be assessed to determine if they are structural controlled and can be traced downdip and along strike within the inferred resource (see press release dated July 3, 2019).

The initial three holes of the 2020 diamond drill program have been established over a strike length of about 40 metres with results of EB-20-02 and 03 expected in the next three weeks. The diamond drill holes tested 50 to 75 metres below surface. For full results of hole EB-20-01, please see press release dated March 2, 2020.

On March 20, 2020, the Issuer announced that, in discussions with its diamond drill contractor, Vital Drilling, and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, diamond drilling will be suspended immediately. This decision was influenced by the Ontario government's declaration of a state of emergency and the federal recommendation to socially isolate. Resumption of exploration efforts will be determined once the various government authorities have indicated that risks to employees and contractors have abated.

The Issuer's exploration team is continuing to work from home and will be complying with all federal and provincial COVID-19 directives. By way of clarification, the company is not aware of any coronavirus cases involving its employees or their families.
