During the month of October 2017, the Issuer entered into an agreement to commence a commercial program to provide the Moose Cree Community, located 20 km south of James Bay in Northern Ontario, with a next generation logistics solution by drone.

In addition, the Issuer also completed a bought-deal prospectus offering, underwritten by GMP Securities L.P., through the issuance of an aggregate of 23,100,000 common shares of the Issuer at a price of \$0.65 per common share for aggregate gross proceeds of \$15,015,000. The common shares were offered by way of a short form prospectus filed in all provinces of Canada.

Working with federal regulators and community stakeholders, the Issuer is set to commence commercial test flights within the Moose Cree geography which is located 20 km south of James Bay in Northern Ontario. Various goods to be shipped would include mail, food, medical supplies, and general goods.
