Report on Business

Progress continues on the Exploration Plan for the Tahami Projects, located in Segovia, Antioquia. The 3D geological model is currently being updated based on geochemical data, detailed core logging, and geophysical interpretation.

In parallel, exploration activities at Tahami Center are advancing and include rock channel sampling, detailed geological mapping, sampling and logging of artisanal mine workings.

At Tahami Southeast, the stream sediment program has been completed, and exploration is currently advancing with rock sampling and geological mapping at 1:10,000 scale.

2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

The 3D geological model for the Tahami South Project is currently under interpretation following the completion of QA/QC validation of the dataset. The integration and compilation of all data layers are essential to support a robust interpretation, including detailed core logging, structural measurements, and the definition of lithological, alteration, and mineralization domains.

At Tahami Center, exploration activities are focused on the continuation of geological mapping at a 1:5,000 scale, along with detailed structural and hydrothermal alteration and lithological mapping. Additional fieldwork includes systematic underground and surface rock channel sampling, as well as grab and panel rock sampling. Development of the 3D geological model will continue in April, incorporating detailed geological mapping and structural measurements.

The raw data from the ground geophysical surveys at Tahami South have been received and are currently undergoing quality control. This process will support integration into the 3D model and subsequent geological interpretation.

At the Tahami Center Project, management is currently focused on advancing exploration activities. Ongoing work includes the interpretation of detailed geological mapping, channel rock sampling. The drone-based geophysical survey (radiometry–magnetometry) has been completed and demonstrates a clear correlation with a classic porphyry system model.
