The Issuer entered into an Assignment agreement (the “Agreement”) with the New Tech dated June 21, 2019. New Tech is an arm’s length party. The purchase and sale of the Claims is conditional upon the following:

- (a) **acceptance for filing of this Agreement on behalf of the Issuer by the Canadian Securities Exchange;**
- (b) **Cash payment of \$10,000 and issuance of 220,205 shares upon 5 days of signing the Agreement;**
- (c) **Issuing up to 200,000 additional common shares upon New Tech satisfying certain obligations pursuant to the Agreement;**
- (d) **Explorex incurring a total expenditure of \$700,000 over a period of 3 years;.**
- (e) **Upon completion of a feasibility study, New Tech maintains the right to purchase (i.e. buy back) a 20% interest in the Project by paying to Explorex an amount equal to 40% of the expenditures incurred by Explorex on the Project**


