EVI Global Group Signs Letter of Intent

Vancouver, BC – September 6, 2017: EVI Global Group Developments Corp. (CSE: EVI) (the “Company”) announces that it has signed a Letter of Intent and negotiated terms to acquire Cannaviri Laboratories Ltd., (“Cannaviri”) a Vancouver based internet marketing company that has developed and is currently distributing natural hemp based CBD (“Cannabidiol”) products. The Company expects to acquire a 100% interest by the issuance of up to 10 million shares of the Company in milestone based tranches.

Cannaviri has been producing and selling natural CBD formulations utilizing hemp since 2015. “With a focus on “full spectrum” formulations, Cannaviri delivers some of the best hemp based CBD products on the market.” according to owner Mathew Kyska. “With a market looking for non-THC (“Tetrahydrocannabinol”) derived CBD, Cannaviri is poised to expand their share of a rapidly growing market.”

The *Hemp Business Journal* (HBJ), the hemp industry's authority on big data and market intelligence recently released [The CBD Report](#) showing cannabidiol as one of the fastest growing market categories in the U.S. hemp and legal marijuana industries with a compound annual growth rate of 59%. *Hemp Business Journal* estimates the total U.S. CBD market will grow to a \$2.1 Billion market in consumer sales by 2020 with \$450 million of those sales coming from hemp based sources. Projections to date for 2016 indicate the hemp-derived CBD market is poised to grow to \$115 million by the end of the year.

“The Company and EVI believe that the market space between big pharma and THC based CBD producers is an underserved space that will benefit from advanced awareness and a consistent supply of high quality CBD offerings.” According to CEO Ron Miles. “We look forward to working with Cannaviri and helping them realize their aspirations and growth plans for an eager world market.”

Cannabidiol belongs to a family of cannabinoids commonly found in the cannabis plant. It is a compound found in many plants that is utilized for treating a wide variety of medical issues. Cannabidiol has become popular in the last several years due to the spotlight on the medical cannabis industry. The cannabis plant is one of the prominent sources for CBD extraction but in recent years, hemp has proven to be an alternate source without the hallucinogenic properties of its sister plant, cannabis.

Management will continue to update the market on the activities and developments within the Company as the terms of the Letter of Intent are fulfilled.
