The Company has changed its name to CleanGo Innovations Inc. in conjunction with the previously announced plan of arrangement with Clean Go Green Go Inc.

During the month of August, the Company closed a private placement in two tranches, issuing 2,500,000 units at a price of \$0.40 per unit for proceeds of \$1,000,000.

The Company obtained Exchange approve at the end of August for its acquisition of Clean Go Green Go Inc. ("CGGG") pursuant to a plan of arrangement (the "Arrangement"), and a special resolution (the "Continuation Resolution") authorizing the continuation of CleanGo Innovations Inc. out of the province of British Columbia into the province of Alberta, conditional upon completion of the Arrangement. The Company also filed a Listing Statement for CleanGo Innovations Inc., the resulting issuer.

CleanGo Innovations Inc. continues to be halt traded pending the approval of the Arrangement with Clean Go Green Go Inc. as a fundamental change by the CSE.

During the month of August, the Company closed a private placement in two tranches, issuing 2,500,000 units at a price of \$0.40 per unit for proceeds of \$1,000,000. On August 18 the Company closed the first tranche, issuing 545,625 units for proceeds of \$218,250. On August 26 the Company closed the second and final tranche, issuing 1,954,375 units for proceeds of \$781,750.

Each Unit consisted of one common share in the capital of the Company and one-half Share purchase warrant. Each whole warrant is exercisable for a period of 18 months at an exercise price of CAD \$0.70 per common share. The warrants are subject to an acceleration provision.
