- On February 26, 2024, the Issuer issued 13,400,000 units at US\$0.27 each by way of a public offering. Each unit consists of one common share (or one pre-funded warrant to purchase one common share in lieu thereof) and one warrant to purchase one common share by February 26, 2029 at US\$0.36, subject to adjustment.

On closing of the public offering, 11,200,000 common shares, 2,200,000 pre-funded warrants and 13,400,000 warrants underlying the units were issued. In addition, 670,000 underwriter's warrants were issued. The said 2,200,000 pre-funded warrants were exercised for common shares upon closing.
