During the month of March, the Company announced it had received shareholder approval for the previously announced arrangement agreement with its wholly-owned subsidiary, Origen Resources Inc. The Company received the final order from the Supreme Court of British Columbia on March 13, 2020.

On March 23, the Company closed its previously announced non-brokered private placement for total gross proceeds of up to \$500,038, issuing 2,272,900 common shares at a price of \$0.22 per common share. Explorex intends to use the gross proceeds from the Private Placement for working capital purposes and to provide a portion of the cash to Spinco under the Arrangement.

During March, the Issuer's management continued to focus on the share exchange agreement and plan of arrangement as detailed in the press release dated December 23, 2019.

The Company held their annual general meeting on March 9 in Vancouver, BC. All the matters submitted to the shareholders for approval as set out in the Company's notice of meeting and information circular dated Feb. 12, 2020, were approved by the requisite majority of votes cast at the AGM. Davidson & Company LLP, Chartered Professional Accountants were re-appointed as auditors of the Company for the ensuing year.
