**Management has been focused on securing additional acquisitions in the USA and worldwide, and expanding the value chain the company is able to offer in the cannabis sector.**

It has been active in planting its JV in Italy, and expanding its operations in Washington State, California, and Nevada.

Management was very busy building and growing the Company, not only in the United States but in Europe as well, with a goal to make this one of the largest global cannabis firms.

In the United States, here's a summary of activity on a state-by-state basis

#### Nevada

The Company's tenant been issued a formal Nevada hemp license covering all 240 pivoted acres of CROP's Nye County, Nevada farm. Planting has been completed on 120 acres and is now underway on an additional 120 acres, consisting of only approved organic and natural materials in agriculture production in order to be deemed an Organic operation.

#### California

Required security upgrades have been completed on its Humboldt County Property, and its tenant planted 20,000 square feet of recreational cannabis.

#### Washington State

The Company completed the retrofit and upgrades at its 'The Park' state-of-the-art facility in Washington State. Crop's licensed tenant grower there has now advised that it expects to harvest an initial 350 pounds of high quality cannabis within six weeks and will be at full scale production in September 2018.

At its other facility in Washington State, it received the final water permits for its "The Dozen" cannabis greenhouse facility in Washington State. Phase one of construction, consisting of site preparation and foundations for twelve (12) purpose-built indoor agricultural canopies encompassing a planned total area of ~44,000 square feet is nearing completion.

International, the Company has been focused on expanding its operations in Italy:

#### Italy

The Company planted 25 acres or 1,089,000 square feet of high CBD 'Cannabis Light' in North Eastern Italy. This represents over a 100% increase on the previously announced capacity announced in press release dated June 27th 2018.

**CROP entered into a member interest purchase agreement with Elite Ventures LLC, of Nevada, to acquire a 49% member interest in a Nye County, Nevada agricultural property. The company has agreed to pay \$1,300,000 USD, in cash, for the member interest and has paid \$600,000 to date. The property totals over 315 acres and includes 300 acres of private water rights, with 240 acres under automatic irrigation pivots that also have automatic fertilizer injection systems installed.**

**The Company entered in to a joint venture agreement whereby the company has a 49% interest in a zero-cost lease of a 217,000 sq. foot property ideally situated for future Cannabis production and extraction. The Five acres of prime agricultural land has been secured in the Westmoreland Parish, some of the most fertile land in Jamaica.**
