ESI is a pipeline equipment rental and sales company with principal operations in Leduc, Alberta and Phoenix, Arizona. The Company currently operates in most provinces in western Canada as well as in the United States of America. The Company, through its operating subsidiaries, ESI Energy Services Inc. ("ESI") and Ozzie's Pipeline Padder, Inc. ("OPI"), supplies (rentals and sales) backfill separation machines ("Padding Machines") to mainline pipeline contractors and utility pipeline contractors as well as oilfield pipeline and construction contractors.

On May 17, 2018, The Company entered into an early stage Process Facility and Cobalt Supply Agreement (the "Agreement") with Battery Minerals Resources Limited ("BMR") for BMR's cobalt-focused mineral exploration claims located in Ontario. BMR is a privately owned Australian multi-commodity battery materials exploration company.

Management remains focused on growing the business through internally generated growth opportunities.
