- *The Issuer, through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Carberry, operates as a branded cannabis products manufacturer with operations in the State of California. Its products consist of cannabis-infused edibles, which the Issuer sells to the adult-use, or recreational, market. Carberry holds an annual license issued by the State of California Department of Public Health, Manufactured Cannabis Safety Branch pursuant to the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act to extract and manufacture cannabis- infused products at its facility located in Adelanto, California. The Issuer's products are infused with cannabis oil, which is sourced from licensed suppliers located in California. The Issuer has arrangements with licensed distributors to sell products under the PLUS™ family of brands to licensed dispensaries and delivery service customers.*

The Issuer continues to focus efforts on increasing market share in the California and Nevada edibles markets through sales to licensed distributors. The company also sells 100% hemp edibles through its direct to consumer platform and health and wellness retailers in the US.

February 3, 2021: The issuer announced an extraordinary meeting of holders of 8.00% unsecured convertible debentures due February 28, 2021 (the "Debentures").

February 4, 2021: The issuer announced that it has entered into a partnership with CannRx Biosciences ("CannRx"), a leading Israeli cannabis firm in the boutique field of cannabis-based botanical medicine, to enhance the onset of the Company's products.

February 16, 2021: The issuer announced a strategic shift to expand its sales team, internalize all account management, and transition to a self-service distribution partner in the California adult-use market.

February 25, 2021: The issuer announced that, further to its press release dated February 3, 2021, holders (the "Debentureholders") of the Company's 8.00% unsecured convertible debentures due February 28, 2021 (the "Debentures") have approved by way of signed instruments in writing in the form of the Form of Proxy, certain proposed amendments to the terms of the Debentures (the "Debenture Amendments") and proposed resolutions for consideration (the "Resolution Amendments" and together with the Debenture Amendments, the "Amendments"). The Amendments have therefore been validly approved.
