Report on Business

The Issuer has been active in its ongoing development of its retail and franchise strategy while simultaneously exploring strategic capital opportunities to support its growth.

Regional Update

BC: The Issuer's wholly-owned subsidiary Spirit Leaf Inc.'s franchise partners have submitted 6 non-medical cannabis retail license applications to The British Columbia Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch for its secured locations and continue to progress through the due diligence process.

Alberta: The Issuer's wholly-owned subsidiary Spirit Leaf Corporate Inc. and its franchise partners continue to work with Alberta Gaming Liquor and Cannabis (AGLC) on final approvals of its other municipally approved Alberta sites that are in various stages of development. The Issuer and its franchise partners now have 50 approved municipal development permits (12 corporate & 38 franchise locations).

The Issuer now has its 3 corporate stores in Calgary (Beltline), Edmonton (Whyte Avenue) and Jasper fully approved and in the licensing queue with the AGLC and several franchise locations also complete and in the licensing queue.

Saskatchewan: The Issuer's franchise partner continues to operate the Issuer's flagship Saskatchewan location in Moose Jaw.

Ontario: The Issuer entered into an agreement with one of the initial 25 retail cannabis lottery winners in the province of Ontario, as selected by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario ("AGCO"). The lottery winner received a license to open a Spiritleaf retail cannabis store on Princess Street in the heart of Kingston, Ontario on April 1, 2019.

The Issuer continued to evaluate and develop opportunities to participate in the Ontario market in accordance with the recently announced regulations and the requirements of the AGCO. It commenced construction on its Bloor Street flagship that will sell non-cannabis products and introduce the Toronto market to the Spiritleaf brand until such time that it is permitted to sell cannabis.

The Issuer continued to develop its infrastructure to support retail and franchise operations. Investments have been made in marketing, human resources, point of sale, accounting, design, a customized cannabis menu app, and an online Spirit Hub to allow employees to continue to learn, grow and collaborate across the chain.

Management has been focused on several key initiatives:

- 1) Exploring strategic partnerships and opportunities to strengthen its balance sheet to capitalize on cannabis opportunities across Canada which includes ongoing business development discussions
- 2) Preparing Spiritleaf stores and franchise partners for all aspects of opening a successful retail store which includes but is not limited to staff hiring & training, effective operations, point of sales systems, merchandising, product assortment, etc.
- 3) Ongoing management of the entire Watch It! chain which includes 13 stores (6 corporate & 7 franchise) along with its ecommerce sites (www.watchit.ca & www.mediumwatches.com)
- 4) Various investment relations activities including working with investor relations consultants, contacting investment advisors and analysts, conducting interviews and meetings.
- 5) Continuing all marketing initiatives including digital optimization activities to promote, educate and familiarize customers with the Spiritleaf brand. Various other strategic marketing activities are under development for all company divisions including the development of the Spirit Fund (www.spiritfund.ca).
- 6) Working with the AGLC and other provincial regulators and local municipalities to satisfy licensing and permitting requirements.

The Issuer continues to work on the development of its 5 cannabis house brands which includes working with its streaming partners, strain selection, packaging and other items.

The Issuer is also designing and developing additional Spiritleaf accessories.

Japan Tobacco Inc. did not file a letter of opposition with the CIPO office against the company's Spirit Leaf and Spirit Joint trademarks. The company subsequently received authorization notification that it can register its Trademarks for both Spirit Leaf and Spirit Joints.

17. Discuss any trends which are likely to impact the Issuer including trends in the Issuer's market(s) or political/regulatory trends.

The Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis ("AGLC") issued a temporary suspension on the issuance of cannabis retail licenses but did issue an additional 10 licenses in February of which a Spiritleaf franchise received one license. While the temporary suspension remains in place, neither Spirit Leaf nor the franchisees of Spirit Leaf can submit applications for, or in the case of cannabis retail license applications that were in progress prior to the enactment of the temporary suspension, receive final approval for cannabis retail licenses to operate retail cannabis stores in the Province of Alberta. As at the date hereof, the AGLC has not yet indicated when it anticipates lifting the temporary suspension.

The Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) announced that under the new revised Ontario regulations, a corporation is not eligible to be issued a retail operator license if more than 9.9% of the corporation is owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by one or more licensed producers or their affiliates. As at the date hereof, more than 9.9% of the issued and outstanding common shares are owned and controlled, directly or indirectly, by one or more licensed producers or their affiliates. Consequently, the Company and its subsidiaries, including Spirit Leaf, are currently prohibited from obtaining retail operator licenses for corporate stores in the province of Ontario under the Ontario regulations. There is no such prohibition on franchise stores which is the Issuer's focus in Ontario. AGCO also announced that it will issue licenses up to a maximum of 75 per brand and the first round of 25 licenses were issued by lottery in January of 2019. Spiritleaf entered into a retail and licensing agreement with one of the lottery winners to open a Spiritleaf store in Kingston, Ontario.
