Within the cannabis sector, RDT provides a turn-key Managed Strip Service Program which enables RDT's QuickStrip™ proprietary drug delivery technology to be licensed by select partners. RDT's service-based annuity contracts drive recurring revenue which enables rapid expansion into emerging markets — generating value for consumers and shareholders. RDT is committed to continually create innovative solutions aimed at multiple consumer segments and future market needs — including humans, animals and plants.

RDT entered into a binding Letter of Intent dated January 7, 2021 to amalgamate 25544737 Ontario Limited, o/a Consolidated Craft Brands with a wholly owned RDT subsidiary, created for the purpose of completing the

transaction and operating the CCB business going forward utilizing the Consolidated Craft Brand name.

The transaction is a share exchange between the parties with a value of \$5 million consisting of \$3,000,000 of cash and cash equivalents and \$2,000,000 of other net assets.

RDT is issuing 16,666,667 common share units in exchange for all of the issued and outstanding shares of 25544737 Ontario Limited. The common share units consist of one common share of RDT and one transferable warrant which may be exchanged for one common share for a price of \$0.45 expiring 24 months the date of closing. Closing is scheduled for February 15th, 2021.
