Global Health Clinics' latest clinic will be located at the highly visible Wellness Mall in downtown Halifax.

Global Health Clinics' Halifax location also provides telemedicine services, which will be used to assist patients in rural areas of Nova Scotia as well as Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland, providing options available through Health Canada-approved licensed producers. The company's clinical staff will work in tandem with physicians to provide safe and effective medical cannabis protocols.

Global Health Clinics has retained Link Media LLC to further build awareness and provide communications and market awareness services aimed at maintaining and building the profile of Global Health Clinics among existing and potential shareholders.

Link Media will arrange and disseminate independent third party research articles. Each article will be reviewed and approved by the company, which will retain editorial control to maintain consistency among the published material to ensure that information is consistent with the company's public disclosure filings on SEDAR.

Link Media is an arm's-length service provider to the company and will be paid \$150,000 (U.S.) in cash under the engagement for its services to the

company. To the knowledge of Global Health Clinics, Link Media does not own any of the company's securities.

The licensed producer, located on Vancouver Island, will provide dedicated staff members not just throughout British Columbia but nationally to educate and support the staff Global Health Clinics when talking to patients and issuing ACMPR licences during business hours. Further the licensed producer will give Global Health Clinic patients priority processing/on-boarding, allowing them to order instantaneously, significantly decreasing patient processing/ordering time.

Global Health Clinics will work with this producer as its premium LP giving patients a 10-per-cent discount on its first purchases.
