The Company engaged SJ Geophysics who commenced geophysical surveys on the Skyfire property, located near 100 Mile House in British Columbia.

The Company has granted an aggregate of 1,600,000 restricted share units to certain directors and officers of the Company pursuant to the Company's amended restricted share unit plan dated effective September 9, 2020. The Plan was approved by the shareholders of the Company on January 8, 2021. The RSUs vest on January 19, 2021 and will expire on September 30, 2024.

The Company has entered into debt settlement agreements with management and past consultants, settling \$40,000 through the issuance of 400,000 common shares at a deemed price of \$0.10 per debt share.

Mansa Exploration is focused on exploring the Skyfire Property located in the Caribou Mining area of central British Columbia, Canada.
