Seahawk continues to focus its attention on its 100% owned mineral properties in the Urban-Barry Greenstone Belt region within the Abitibi sub-province, Quebec, Canada. Due to the current Covid-19 situation, all planned exploration activities have been temporarily suspended and will be reinitiated when conditions are deemed to be safe.

The company continues to work towards closing the agreement (dated April 30, 2021) with Sama Resources Inc. for the acquisition of Sama’s Zwedru South Project, St-John River Gold Project and the Nuon Project, each of which is located in Liberia, Africa (see news release dated May 4, 2021).

On June 18, 2021, the company announced the changing of its ticker symbol on the Canadian Securities Exchange from “SHV” to “SEAG” effective June 24, 2021(see news release dated June 18, 2021).

Seahawk was very encouraged with the exploration program to further evaluate the Urban-Barry properties. The phase 1 program was to follow up on priority geophysical and geological targets that were identified during the prospecting and geophysical surveys. Management continues to review the data base and formulate plans for the next exploration programs on our properties.
