has also mineral mining license covering 42.12 hectares of same areas in the mineral exploration license in Kharganii am-1, Bornuur soum, Tuv aimag, Mongolia.

The Issuer also has a mineral mining license over the Khaldun iron (zinc) mine located in Govi-Ugtaal Sum, Middle Govi (Dundgovi) province, Mongolia.

The Issuer continues to seek additional funding to further its exploration activities and operations and the opportunities in its primary activities.
