 - During the month of April 2019, Management continued its focus on driving solid financial returns for shareholders from the Superstore, both out of its current footprint of 16,000 square feet of dispensary space as well as through the profitable expansion into the full 112,000 square feet of available space on the site that are part of its planned cannabis entertainment complex, such as the coffee shop/bistro, event space and customer facing production facility.
