The Issuer has estimated that, as of the date of this report, the review of its continuous disclosure materials by the Ontario Securities Commission (the "OSC") had delayed the launch of the first marketable version of its ie-Pulse macroeconomic data index series by four to six months. The review, which must be completed before the failure-to-file cease-trade-order (the "FFCTO") placed on the Issuer's securities by the OSC can be lifted, was still ongoing as of the date of this report. The ongoing review has prevented the Issuer from raising the capital it needs to help it access more business data and meet the Issuer's original minimum data requirements to develop viable versions of the indexes. However, in order not to delay the launch of the indexes further, the Issuer began assessing the possibility of lowering its minimum data requirement for index viability during the period to see if some indexes comprised of a fewer number of companies could be released commercially within days of the completion of the OSC review without the need for additional data from new companies registered on the Issuer's Cubeler Business Development Platform.

While a lack of capital continued to hamper the Issuer's North American operations, there were no such issues for the Issuer in China as activity on the Issuer's platforms there slowly resumed during the period following the expected Chinese New Year holiday pause.

The Issuer's management and the Issuer's auditors continued to work with the OSC during the period, as part of the OSC's review of the Issuer's continuous disclosure materials, to get the Issuer's disclosure materials in compliance with Canadian securities regulations so that the FFCTO can be lifted. Although the review was still ongoing as of the date of this report and no timetable was established for its conclusion, management believes that significant progress was made during the period to get the process close to a resolution.
