Prophecy DeFi Inc. (PDFI) is a publicly traded investment company whose primary objective is to invest its funds for the purpose of generating returns from capital appreciation and income. It plans to accomplish these goals by bringing together technology start-ups in the Blockchain and Decentralized Finance sectors to fund

innovation, elevate industry research, and create new business opportunities in a coherent ecosystem.

During the month of May 2026, the Company announced that the Ontario Securities Commission had issued a failure-to-file cease trade order against the Company as a result of the Company not filing its audited consolidated financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2025, annual management's discussion and analysis for the same period, and related management certifications by the April 30, 2026 filing deadline.

The Company disclosed that the delay was primarily due to the complexities associated with the recent conversion of debentures, which required additional time for the auditors to complete their work. The Company continued to work diligently with its auditors to complete the required annual filings and advised that it did not expect an interruption to its operations during the cease trade order.

On May 20, 2026, the Company provided a further update on the status of the required annual filings and disclosed that it expected the required annual filings to be completed on or around May 29, 2026. The Company also stated that there was no material information concerning the affairs of the Company that had not been generally disclosed.
