## Report on Business

### 1. Provide a general overview and discussion of the development of the Issuer's business and operations over the previous month. Where the Issuer was inactive disclose this fact.

Relay Medical continues to develop and productize multiple products and projects concurrently as well as to consider strategic opportunities that are complimentary to current infrastructure assets. Relay is concurrently developing products within wholly owned subsidiary Cybeats Technologies Inc. ("Cybeats"), the Fionet Rapid Response Group ("FRR"), the HemoPalm platform and related In Vitro Diagnostics products, Pharmatrac and Osprey Device Networks Corp. (formerly Relay MedNet) as well as the initial development of partially owned subsidiary Glow Lifetech Ltd.

The Company, through its joint-venture subsidiary ("FRR") continues to provide on-site antigen Rapid Diagnostic Tests (RDTs) and Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Tests at Pearson Toronto International Airport. FRR is the system provider for all scheduling, registration, processing of results, and communication to passengers and the Lab Information System which connects the Health Authorities.

### 2. Provide a general overview and discussion of the activities of management.

Relay completed the acquisition of wholly owned subsidiary Cybeats in late March 2021, and has since been engaged in the integration and scale-up of the platform solution to address market interest. Significant to this transaction, there has been increased global attention to Software Bill of Materials (SBOM) and the need to track and monitor the supply chain of software, as mandated by the May 12th White House executive order. The Company has quickly expanded the development team to accelerate the commercialization of Cybeats and increased business development resources to support sales activities. The Cybeats platform is now commercially available with three pilots underway. Initial pilots include two mid-sized companies based in North America, and a multinational IoT company, from different market segments.

Relay and its joint venture Fionet Rapid Response Group, deployed the Fionet platform through the U.S. Agency for International Development ("USAID") in 144 Remote Community-Based Healthcare Sites in the Democratic Republic of the Congo to fight a malaria pandemic in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

Relay and its joint venture Fionet Rapid Response Group, deployed the Fionet Platform for rapid testing and real-time tracking of COVID-19 at the 2021 National Bank Open presented by Rogers tennis tournament in Toronto.

During the month, the Company received certification by Florida-based Tritan Software Corporation ("Tritan"). Tritan's SeaCare® is the first and only complete enterprise software solution for global medical operations within the maritime industry. Relay becoming a Tritan SeaCare® API Certified Partner provides Relay with products and tools to support SeaCare® clients, such as the Cruise Line Industry in gathering critical data. The SeaCare® API Certified Partners program was created to vet third party vendors that aim to leverage the SeaCare® platform for integrations in order to provide them with all of the proper tools and training to develop their solutions.

The Company will provide rapid COVID- 19 testing and real-time tracking at Canada's 2022 FIFA World Cup Qatar qualifying matches in Toronto, ON. Canada will play Honduras on September 2 and El Salvador on September 8 at BMO Field as part of the Concacaf Final Round qualifying games for the prestigious 2022 FIFA World Cup™ in Qatar. Athletes will be tested for COVID-19 upon arrival into Toronto and then retested in the days leading up to qualifying matches. The testing will take place near the event venue, the BMO field, in downtown Toronto.

Relay also made progress on the development of a new home and small business testing system based on the Company's Pharmatrac platform. The universal device and mobile app allow for use of lateral flow diagnostic kits, including COVID-19 antigen and antibody tests.

As another vote of confidence, FRR has been selected to provide rapid COVID- 19 testing and real-time tracking at Canada's 2022 FIFA World Cup Qatar qualifying matches in Toronto, ON. Canada will play Honduras on September 2 and El Salvador on September 8 at BMO Field as part of the Concacaf Final Round qualifying games for the prestigious 2022 FIFA World Cup™ in Qatar. Athletes will be tested for COVID-19 upon arrival into Toronto and then retested in the days leading up to qualifying matches. The testing will take place near the event venue, the BMO field, in downtown Toronto.

During September, FRR announced an agreement reached in principle with Rwanda Ministry of Health to deploy the Fionet Platform for containment of Rwanda's malaria epidemic. The parties are finalizing the details of the deployment under which the Rwanda Ministry of Health will pay over CAD \$750,000 to FRR in order to pilot the Fionet Platform for six months. If successful, this pilot is expected to lead to a country-wide deployment of the Fionet Platform, which could scale to a nation-wide program. Funding will be provided to the Rwanda Ministry of Health from a world leading US-based charitable foundation.

Fionet Rapid Response Group ("FRR"), will provide rapid COVID-19 testing and real-time tracking at the 46th edition of the Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF). The 46th edition of the Toronto International Film Festival features 10 days of exceptional international and Canadian cinema with close to 200 films in its Official Selection, unparalleled events featuring acclaimed industry guests, and TIFF's Industry Conference. Recognized as the world's largest public film festival, TIFF is bringing the theatrical experience back to life and continues its reputation as both a leader in amplifying under-represented cinematic voices and a bellwether for programming award-winning films from around the globe

Relay is also pleased to announce an agreement with the global IT solutions company, Unisys Corporation (NYSE: UIS) , for jointly marketing a combined solution, that includes FRR's Fionet Platform for pandemic and biosecurity management, for the large, underserved biosecurity market. FRR's Fionet Platform for pandemic and biosecurity management will be integrated with Unisys' best-in-class U-Pass™ , which digitally authenticates individuals' health status. This combination of Fionet mobile testing, triage, and reporting capabilities and U-Pass' mobile authentication technologies will both increase and simplify biosecurity management capability for clients from markets such as large enterprises, governments, transport and maritime industries.

Relay is also pleased to report on the signing of a definitive agreement and provide an update on the deployment to combat the malaria epidemic in Rwanda, East Africa. The Rwanda Ministry of Health signed a procurement agreement with FRR to deploy the Fionet Platform for decentralized malaria testing. Under the terms of the agreement, FRR will receive CAD \$750,000, which has been already secured by the Ministry, to deploy the Fionet Platform for six months for use by 180 community-based healthcare workers. The six-month deployment is a pilot to evaluate a national scale up, which could then lead to a subsequent agreement to deploy Fionet for Rwanda's 60,000 heal

Management continued to be involved in the development of its business through new products and services as more specifically detailed in 1 and 2 above.

**11. Discuss any trends which are likely to impact the Issuer including trends in the Issuer's market(s) or political/regulatory trends.**

On March 12, 2020, the World Health Organization ("WHO") declared a global pandemic as a result of the COVID-19 virus. The impacts on global commerce are expected to be far reaching and, at this point, unknown. The global lock-down impacts have negatively

impacted the economy as a whole and capital markets in Canada. The effects on the Company's operations have been minor to date but management continues to monitor and contingency plan.

On September 4 2020, Health Canada announced new steps towards gaining control over the COVID-19 pandemic by supporting community-based testing solutions: (1) it will support enhanced solutions for airport testing; (2) it invited potential solutions to be submitted for home testing; and (3) it authorized clinical trials for rapid diagnostics tests ("RDTs") which are fast, inexpensive test strips that can be used in locations outside of laboratories.

On May 12, 2021, United States President Joe Biden, through an executive order, outlined a policy making cybersecurity a top priority and essential that the U.S. Federal Government lead by example for all Federal Information Systems to exceed the standards and requirements set forth by the order. The order's primary mandate is to enhance the integrity of software supply chains by requiring a Software Bill of Materials (SBOM), a solution that is already at the core of Relay Medical's Cybeats' cybersecurity platform.
