Resumed drilling at New Alger

This program will drill several longer holes across the Cadillac Break, through the Piché volcanics and into the Pontiac sediments, further exploring the first, where Renforth recently discovered new gold occurrences, and getting deeper pierce points within the Piché, which hosts the existing identified mineralization on the property.

New Alger announces drill results from first holed from current drill program

The first hole drilled in the 2020 drill program. REN-20-38, a successful 110m step out to the west from any previous Renforth drilling of the Piché volcanics, is additional validation of the results obtained in the 1940’s drilling by Alger Gold Mines Limited which demonstrate gold mineralization across the entire western portion of New Alger. With this drillhole, the furthest west, Renforth notes that, once again, the mineralized zones are associated not only with the quartz veins, there is additional width provided by the gold bearing alteration halo, also present in the eastern portion of the property. In this hole the typical blue/grey quartz veins are not as robust as they are to the east, possibly pinching. In the zones there are several competent lithologies present which have been fractured and brecciated,

displaying carbonate, sericite and biotite alteration, these are carrying gold over widths greater than the width of the veins.
