

**Softlab9 Software Solutions Inc.
Announces Consolidation**

Vancouver, B.C. - (August 23, 2019) – SoftLab9 Software Solutions Inc. (CSE: SOFT) (FSE: APO1) (the “Company” or “SoftLab9”), announces that the Company will be completing a share consolidation on the basis of one (1) post-consolidation common share for every thirteen (13) pre-consolidation common shares (the “**Consolidation**”). Effective at the commencement of trading on August 28, 2019 the Company will begin trading on the Canadian Securities Exchange on a post-consolidated basis (there is no name change or ticker symbol change in connection with the Consolidation). The new CUSIP and ISIN are: 83405W205 and CA83405W2058, respectively.

Currently there are 53,830,665 common shares issued and outstanding and after the Consolidation there will be approximately 4,766,668 common shares issued and outstanding. The Company will not be issuing fractional post-Consolidation common shares to shareholders in connection with the Consolidation. Where the Consolidation would otherwise result in a shareholder being entitled to a fractional common share, the number of post-Consolidation common shares issued to such holder of common shares shall be rounded up to the next greater whole number of common shares if the fractional entitlement is equal to or greater than 0.5 and shall be rounded down to the next lesser whole number of common shares if the fractional entitlement is less than 0.5. In calculating such fractional interests, all common shares held by a beneficial holder shall be aggregated.

A letter of transmittal with respect to the Consolidation will be mailed to registered shareholders of the Company. All registered shareholders with physical certificates will be required to send their respective certificates representing pre-consolidated common shares along with a completed letter of transmittal to the Company’s transfer agent, TMX Trust Company (“**TMX**”), in accordance with the instructions provided in the letter of transmittal. Additional copies of the letter of transmittal can be obtained through TMX. All shareholders who submit a duly completed letter of transmittal along with their respective pre-consolidated common share certificate(s) to TMX, will receive a post-consolidation share certificate.

Shareholders who hold their common shares through a broker or other intermediary and do not have common shares registered in their name, will not need to complete a letter of transmittal.

The exercise or conversion price and the number of common shares issuable under any of the Company's outstanding warrants and stock options will be proportionately adjusted to reflect the Consolidation in accordance with their respective terms thereof.

After the Consolidation there will be approximately 366,666 stock options outstanding and no share purchase warrants.
