On March 4, 2022, the Issuer announced that it had retained Hybrid Financial Ltd. ("Hybrid") to provide marketing and investor relations services to the Issuer for an initial term of six months, which automatically renews for successive three-month periods, unless terminated by the Issuer. Hybrid is paid a monthly fee of C\$22,500 plus applicable taxes.

On March 16, 2022, the Issuer announced that it had engaged Midnight Sun Drilling Inc. for the Issuer's upcoming maiden drilling campaign at its Toiyabe Project in Lander County, Nevada. The Issuer also announced that Raymond Harari had stepped down as the Issuer's Chief Executive Officer, and was replaced by Colin Moore, the current President of the Issuer. Mr. Moore also joined the Issuer's Board of Directors, bringing the total number of directors to five, four of whom are independent.

On March 22, 2022, the Issuer announced that it had changed its auditor from Dale Matheson Carr-Hilton LaBonte LLP ("DMCL") to Smyth LLP. DMCL had resigned at the request of Issuer. There were no reservations in DMCL's audit report for the period commencing at the beginning of the Issuer's two most recent financial years and ending on March 16, 2022 and there had been no "reportable events" as defined in National Instrument 51-102 *Continuous Disclosure Obligations*.

Raymond Hari resigned as CEO effective March 16, 2022

Colin Moore became CEO and a director of the Issuer effective March 16, 2022 and was appointed to the Issuer's Audit Committee on March 31, 2022 (replacing David Kelley).

The Issuer formed a Compensation and Corporate Governance Committee, which was approved by the Board of Directors on March 31, 2022. The members of the Compensation and Corporate Governance Committee are Charles W. Beil, David Kelley and Johnathan Dewdney.

17. Discuss any trends which are likely to impact the Issuer including trends in the Issuer's market(s) or political/regulatory trends.

The Issuer is likely to be most impacted by the price of gold, due to its right to acquire a 100% interest in the Toiyabe Project, the Turquoise Canyon Project, and the East Saddle Project in Lander County, Nevada. Furthermore, due to its right to acquire a 90% interest in the Mulloy Project in Ontario, graphite prices may also have an impact on the Issuer. The Issuer is also impacted by volatility in the capital markets insofar as that affects the Issuer's ability to continue to raise capital as a junior mineral exploration company.

The COVID-19 pandemic may continue to hinder the Issuer's ability to undertake further exploration work at its projects or at other new assets acquired.
