The 5,000 metre drilling program which commenced January 18th has been completed. The objective of drilling the Black Horse chromite deposit was to expand the inferred resource category to depth. The program met its objective of extending the Black Horse chromite deposit to depth.

("Cliffs") for an Order to dispense with the consent of KWG subsidiary Canada Chrome Corporation ("CCC") for the granting of an easement to Cliffs over mining claims previously staked and assessed by CCC. The motion for leave will be heard on April 28, 2014 and the hearing of the appeal has now been scheduled for June 16 and 17, 2014.**
